Try to make your own dinosaur fossil. Have a look online for different ideas.

You could use salt dough or something else!

Draw a picture of your own made up dinosaur and label its features.

Take part in a dinosaur reading challenge. Every time you read a book at home, you'll earn a piece of a cut-up dinosaur picture. Stick them within a dinosaur outline and see how long it takes you to make the whole picture!







Work with an adult to produce a dinosaur movie or show using toys, puppets or models. Evergreen bushes and a rocky or dusty area of your garden or local park would make perfect film sets!
