

What support is on offer? (cont'd)

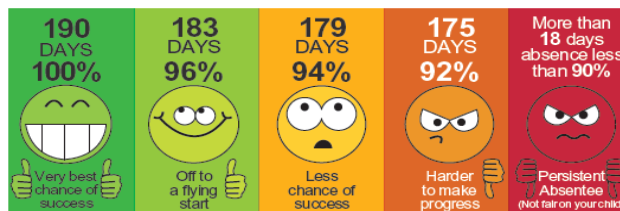
Supporting children in school 1-to-1 and in small groups around a variety of issues including:

- Understanding and managing **emotions**
- Promoting **confidence and self-esteem**
- Supporting around key **transitions**, including moving between classes and schools
- **Friendships and relationships**
- **Family issues** and things that may be happening at home eg. Bereavement, new baby, parent's separation/divorce, family breakdown, parental health and well-being needs.
- Promoting good **attendance** and punctuality
- Promoting **positive behaviour** and **positive attitudes** to learning

Supporting Good Attendance

As well as my supporting children and families role, I will be supporting the schools to promote good attendance.

If you struggle with getting your child into school every day on time, please contact me to see if I can offer you any further support around this to prevent this concern escalating to the level whereby education welfare processes may need to be implemented.

The Family Liaison Officer (FLO).

I support families across schools within the trust.

What does a FLO do?

Sometimes we all need a little bit of help with family life and there are many difficulties that are common across all types of families.

Accessing support when you need it will benefit you and your family in the long term and can make everyone feel much better when things improve.

The trust is working hard to provide Early Help support to families within our school community.

Early Help support aims to provide advice and support to families, with the objective of preventing escalation to higher level services.

It can involve working alongside a variety of agencies to ensure the right support is offered when needed.

My role in school

My role in school is to provide support, advice and information to families who are facing a challenge or difficulty no matter how small.

I can help you with any worries that you may have in relation to your child's education, behaviour and wellbeing and can be a listening ear if you need someone to talk to.

I can meet with you at home or in school at a time to suit you. Advice and support is confidential although concerns relating to the safeguarding of children will always be dealt with in accordance with the school's Safeguarding Policy.

I may not have all the answers, but hopefully I can work with you to bring about positive change!

What support is on offer?

Support can include (but isn't limited to);
Supporting parents/ carers:

- Who are experiencing difficulties in managing their child's **behaviour** or who have concerns around their child's behaviour.
- Whose children are not **attending** school regularly
- Who may need support on a wide range of issues impacting on **family life**
- Who are worried about their child's **emotional health**
- Who would like support around implementing **routines at home**
- Who would like support around **adjusting to any changes** within the family home
- Who would benefit from being signposted to more **specific and targeted services** in the local community including health, housing and wellbeing services
- To **discuss any concerns or worries** in a safe secure environment.
