## Pupil Premium Grant Strategy Statement 2019-2022



### The Pupil Premium Grant

The Pupil Premium is additional funding for publicly funded schools in England to raise the attainment of disadvantaged pupils and close the gap between them and their peers. In 2019/20, the funding allocation is expected to be £1320 per child, £300 for Forces children and £2300 for Looked After Children.

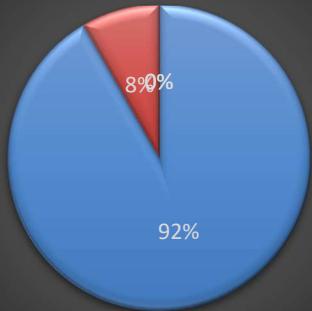

Review: last year's aims and outcomes - <u>The review of 2020-2021 outcomes is on the 2021-2022 strategy statement</u>	
FS1: Attainment in Communication and Language	Attainment was lower compared to 2017-18 however this cohort were achieving lower on baseline (0% expected: 2018-19, 20% expected: 2017-18). Understanding and Speaking attainment evidenced the gap is closing for this cohort. The attainment for the whole cohort was much improved on 2017-18, so quality first teaching is improved. More focus will be placed on improving communication and language through targeted support for PPG pupils.
FS2: Attainment of GLD	GLD attainment was lower for all pupils and disadvantaged pupils. This is a key priority for the school this year.
Y1: Attainment in Phonics	Phonics attainment was broadly in line for disadvantaged pupils. Phonics continues to be a key priority for the school.
Y1: Attainment in Reading	Massive improvement in attainment for disadvantaged pupils in reading at the end of Year One.
Y2: Attainment in Reading	Reading attainment was broadly in line for disadvantaged pupils at the end of Year Two. Phonics continues to be a key priority for the school and will impact on reading attainment.
Y2: Attainment in Writing	Writing attainment was broadly in line for disadvantaged pupils at the end of Year Two. However disadvantaged pupils started at a much lower baseline at the beginning of the year (-25%) evidencing impact of focus on closing the gap.
Y2: Attainment in Mathematics	Massive improvement in attainment for disadvantaged pupils in mathematics at the end of Year Two.

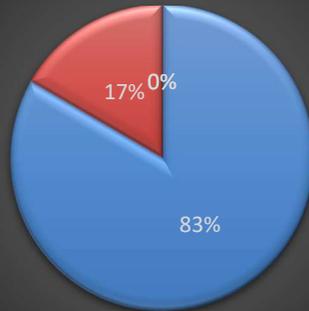
